For: Sporting conduct expectations for all persons participating in or attending athletic contests.

The following behaviors of spectators and players are **unacceptable at all athletic competitions and events.** Violators will be requested to leave the premises; repeated instances of unacceptable behavior will result in exclusion from all after school sporting events for the rest of the season:

- 2. Verbally abusing opponents, teammates, coaches, officials, or other spectators.
- 3. Obscene language or gestures directed at opponents, teammates, coaches, officials, or spectators.
- 4. Physical violence or the threat of physical violence directed at opponents, teammates, coaches, officials, or spectators.
