 - vi. Jenny Schroder: Goal area 1 and 2 seem to separate students, but are both included? Would like to see more collaboration with neighborhoods. In goal 1, many things are not measurable (strong writing skills) and will they require curriculum changes?
 - vii. Alicia Carter: Frustrated that parents/students aren't aware of the many resources available. Would like the district to work together so that schools can implement the same SEL curriculum, etc.
 - viii. Shanna Bengtson: number of assessments done by the district seems overwhelming for students
