ELA: Key Actions

- Provide more grade level collaboration
- Observations and walkthroughs by coaches and administration
- After school ELA homework center for all students
- Use Professional Learning Communities, early release days for more collaboration.
- RTI: intervention period for students that have gaps in ELA skills
- Small group instruction focused on skills (general ed)
- Iready rotations in Instructional Support based on individual student need. (special ed)

Math: Key Actions

- Use PLC and early release days for common planning time and implement pacing guides
- Small group instruction
- Iready rotations in Instructional Support
- RTI for Math 7 and Math 8. For 6th grade not enough students for a full class, but those students who need support are in a co-taught class.
- Use RTI for enrichment/extension.
- All students can access homework support.
- Parent info night for YUP math app to increase usage.

ELL: Key Actions

- Meeting and checking in with students to help them understand the process and monitor progress
- Newcome Success Plan: develop a success plan for newcomers--academic goals and specific supports. Formed by Susie with parents and students.
- SCEF will also work with RFEPs (reclassified students) to focus on grades etc.

Emotional Health and wellness: Key Actions

- Guidance counselor will continue to implement a multi tiered system of support and and intervention
- Continue to offer high quality co and extra curricular activities
- Increase communication with teachers and families regarding instruction and student achievement.

Inclusive and Welcoming culture: Key Actions

- Implement community circles/SEL to support student behavior
- Implement the SART process to support positive attendance rates
- Implement Elevate, focused parent activities with the principal and increase communication about student progress
- Increase principal coffee focused on building relationships
- SEL check-ins at beginning of class
- Create consistent opportunities to revisit our goals from Welcome WEek
- Implemented pilot Boldly Me (SEL curriculum)
- SMARTS curriculum for Instruction Support and Executive Functioning classes
- Monthly SEL lessons by school counselor
- Monthly character trait

Suggestions:

- Peer tutoring
- Tower book challenge (ELA--details in Sheila's tab on input doc)
- Prodigy Math games
- Family/student reading clubs (reading a book, doing a craft)
- Family nights to increase parent participation
- Connect students with mentors (mentor-tutor connection, big brother/big sister)
- Diversity events: Latinx Student Union, leadership, WEB, other clubs, PTA
- Special guests from outside the community
- Learning Ally for dyslexic students (reads books to students) could be used in general ed as well
- Office hours could be offered in future schedules.
- Pairing students with a peer role model for ELD students
- Zen room/Safe Zone
- Kickboxing with MVPD
- Pep rallies or school spirit
- Talent show

- International fair
