The following question appeared on the ballot:^[1]

To continue local school funding, support struggling students, offer competitive compensation to attract and retain the best teachers; maintain small class sizes; enhance hands-on science, technology, math and engineering programs; maintain outstanding music and art education; and support core academics, shall Mountain View Whisman School District levy a tax of \$191 per parcel – an increase of \$64 for most homeowners – for 8 years, generating \$2,800,000 annually, with independent oversight, exemptions for seniors and funds staying local?^[2]
